

TERMINOLOGY

Cover Photo	The large picture at the top of your timeline, above your profile picture. In short, your personal “background”.
Follow	The way you receive news about organizations, groups, celebrities or other Facebook users you’re interested in but not “friends” with.
Friend	People to whom you are connected and with whom you share content.
Group	Close circles of friends that share and keep in touch on Facebook.
Like	The action used to give quick positive feedback on a post or to follow an organization or page.
Message	The method used to have a private conversation with someone.
News Feed	The list of updates visible on your homepage from friends and other Facebook users that you follow.
Profile	The page containing YOUR information on Facebook. Also called your Timeline.
Profile Picture	The picture of you that is visible to other Facebook users and/or the general public (if the appropriate permissions are enabled).
Tag	The action that links a person to a particular picture, place, page, post, or event.
Chat Sidebar	The area on the right side of home page that allows you to what friends are currently online and instant message them. Can be hidden from view.
Timeline	Your personal page on Facebook that is comprised of your photos, updates, likes and other information that tells your story.
Wall	The area on your timeline where you and your friends can post status updates, photos/videos, places you visit and information about significant life events.
